There he studied viticulture, enology, and culinary arts at Alan Hancock College. One of his instructors, who was also a local wine maker, took Josh under his wing, which led to a 10-year apprenticeship in culinary arts and wine production. In that time, he worked with some amazing chefs and winemakers that influenced his career greatly. Later, Josh cooked his way through the central coast of California; from historic haunted hotels to large brewery grand openings. About five years ago, Josh moved to the Mill Creek area to be the Sous Chef of Highlands Ranch Resort. His main focus nowadays is his new business, Against the Grain Catering, with the help of his soon to be wife, Erin Harper. Josh and Erin met in the Pismo Beach area where she acquired an extensive background in the restaurant and service industry. Living a somewhat rural lifestyle, they are currently raising chickens for eggs and run a small garden when water allows.
